Training Day **'Excellence in Safeguarding'**

Our 2023 Seaford Baptist Church safeguarding training day is Saturday 12th August. Our accredited trainer, provided by SEBA, is Colin Povey.

The Baptist Union have developed 'Excellence in Safeguarding' to help the whole church family as well as those working with adults at risk, children or young people, to understand safeguarding specifically within the church context.

On Saturday 12th of August we'll meet for tea, coffee, cold drinks from 9.30am

10am to 12.30 the Level 2 training course is designed for all volunteers and workers who work with adults at risk, children or young people to understand safeguarding specifically within the church context. The training includes:-

- Introduction to safeguarding
- The language of safeguarding some definitions
- Signs and symptoms
- What should I do if ...?
- Roles and responsibilities
- Good practice General
- Good practice Safe Recruitment
- Boundaries

Please bring a packed lunch if you are staying on for Level 3 in the afternoon.

Level 3 training is for Ministers, Trustees & the Designated person for Safeguarding and all who lead groups with adults at risk, children or young people. This training includes:-

- Recognising signs and symptoms of an abuser
- Safer Recruitment
- Writing Safeguarding Policy and Procedures
- Recording and securing evidence
- Questioning skills
- Making a referral
- Offender contracts

Level 2 must be completed before Level 3 because there is information that is covered in Level 2 that is not repeated in Level 3.
