WAVES- Important News

Last week I received a phone call and a letter from Gerry Howitt, the Chair of WAVES with the following sad news

Dear Andy

It is with a heavy heart that I must inform you of some difficult news regarding WAVES Seaford. Despite the unwavering dedication and tireless efforts of our team and trustees, it is with regret that we have reached a point where our financial resources have been depleted, and we are faced with the unavoidable reality of having to close our doors on the 30th of April, 2024.

Over the past three months, significant transformations have taken place within our organization in an effort to streamline our operations and reduce costs without compromising the quality of the essential services we provide. Regrettably, despite all these measures and diligent cost-cutting initiatives, we have been unable to secure the critical funding needed to sustain our operations in accordance with the financial guidelines set by the charity commission.

The news has been shared this week with current WAVES clients and supporters. The staff team were informed last week before it came into the public domain.

WAVES was originally set up as a charity by SBC members, and I know many people from our congregation have contributed to the work of WAVES over the last 25 years. We hope to mark that in some way, to be decided with the current trustees. I would also ask you to pray for the staff, volunteers and trustees over the next month as they wind up the charity; please pray for wisdom and discernment as we consider how the work amongst families may continue. There are still many families in our community who need support and help; if this is an area where you have expertise, and have a real passion for sharing your Christian faith, by putting love into action, then please speak to one of the Leadership Team.

From a practical point of view, if you are contributing to WAVES by a regular standing order, you will need to cancel that payment yourself with your bank. You may wish to reallocate those funds to SBC as we discern how we can continue to support families in Seaford.
