Run the Race

What is important in the Christian life is to run the race with perseverance so that we finish the course as strongly as we started. How do we do this?

Prepare well for the race ahead – wear the right gear. Cast off any clothes that hinder you. You may be carrying words spoken over you that weigh you down. Beware of being tripped up or entangled by worldly or sinful desires that could deflect us from running our Christian race and persevering to the end.

Jesus has run the race before us and persevered through greater hardships than we will ever face. He resisted the temptations that the devil placed before him in the wilderness. He laid aside his majesty, taking off his clothes to wash his disciples' feet. He carried the cross enduring the scorn and beating. He died that sacrificial death on the cross. His last words were 'it is finished'.

What is the finishing line? As followers of Jesus we have a different perspective. The end of our life is the beginning of eternal life in a place where there is no more sadness, no more crying, no more death. Jesus and those who have gone before us are cheering us on to keep going and finish the race well. They have achieved their goal; they have finished the course and received their crowns of righteousness.

My hope is that all of us will finish the course, empowered by the Holy Spirit, keeping our eyes on Jesus the author and perfecter of our faith.
