GIVING

Last Sunday Andy reminded us that all that we have comes from God so when we give financially, we are only giving back to Him what He has given us in the first place. Giving is part of our worship, praise and thanks. When you give money to the Church you are investing in the Kingdom of God. What better investment to make?!

We want to be good stewards of what God gives us and so we have made every effort to cut costs and to limit expenses but some of those are inevitably large. The building must be maintained and heated; our minister and employees must be paid; there are many administrative costs. The Church gives ten percent of all offerings to local, national and overseas missions. Last year (2023) expenditure increased more than income. This year we need the balance to be in surplus, not deficit. We are therefore appealing to all who read this Notice Sheet to consider whether they can help us financially to stay out of debt. The Charity sector in general is struggling financially. WAVES have recently had to close.

When did you last review your giving to the church? When you get a salary or pension increase do you increase your giving accordingly? The best way to give is by Standing Order which you can set up by requesting a form or going online. In the church building there are three collection points for cash or cheque offerings plus a Sum Up machine for card donations. If you are a taxpayer, remember to complete a Gift Aid form so that we can claim an extra 25% from the government on all your gifts.

We rely on God but we also acknowledge that God uses people. We thank you for any contribution you can make. Small amounts all add up and can be used in economy of God's kingdom.
